









Percent Of Retail Sales Attributable To Online In Selected Merchandise Categories (v.s.)




E-Commerce Is Driving Nearly All Retail Growth In US

Online Share Of U.S. Retail Sales



U.S. E-Commerce Retail Sales







Amazon North America Retail Sales




Amazon Market Share Of North America E-Commerce













iTunes Vs. Amazon Kindle Digital Media Revenue





Global Data, By Category, 2013 Estimate




























U.S. Mobile Commerce Spending





Mobile Is Now ¼ Of All E-Commerce Traffic ... E-Commerce Website Traffic By Device





Average Audience Size For Retailers (By Category) On Different Social Networks (U.S.; As Of Nov. 2013)












Alibaba Drives \$157 Billion In Gross Merchandise Value

Taobao And Tmall Annual Retail Sales Volume






